

Camp Fees

Tuition for attendance is based on the regular fee schedule plus \$2 per day for camp fees.

All children attending during camp times will participate in camp activities and be charged a materials fee of \$2 per day and must complete a summer care schedule.

All campers will need to:

- *Bring a water bottle every day.*
- *Arrive with sunscreen already applied.*
- *Wear closed toe shoes every day.*

Important Notices:

Spots will be filled on a first come, first served basis. Serving our current families first. If you are new to Creekside Kids, you will need to complete registration paperwork and a summer schedule dependant upon approval due to limited space. Registration forms can be emailed from the director before enrollment can begin.

Because space is limited, all sessions must be paid for at the time of enrollment.

Refunds may be provided if notice of cancellation is received no later than 2 weeks prior to the beginning of each camp session.
